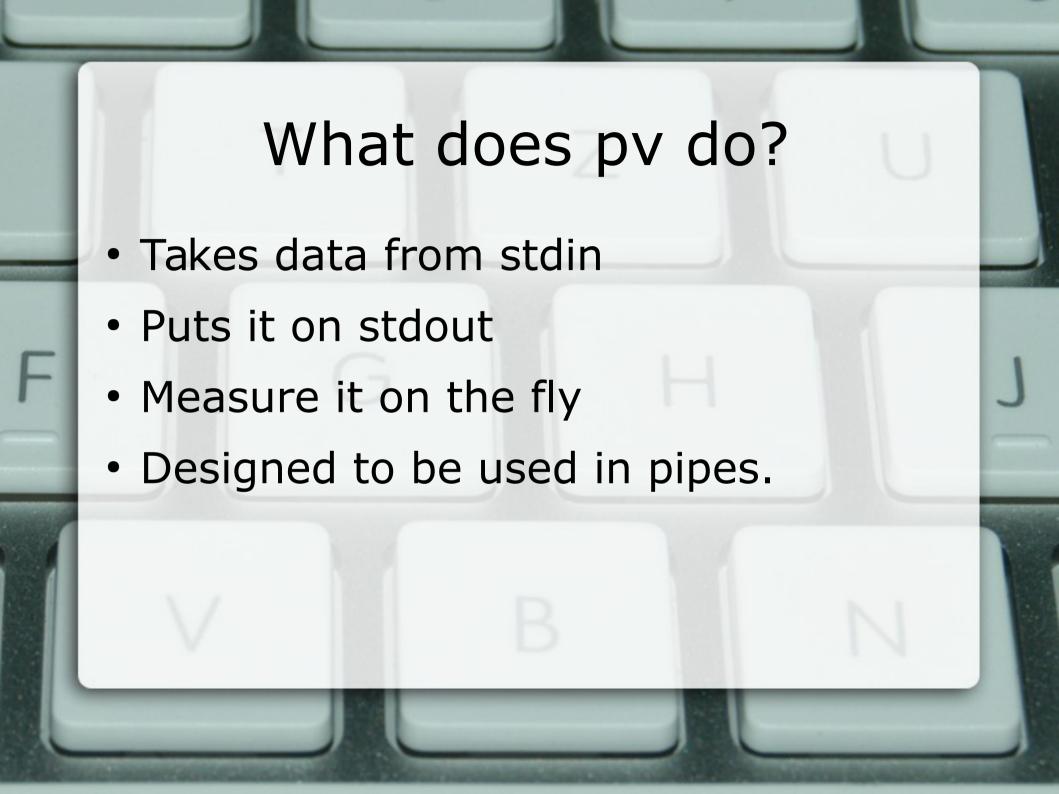
Cool tools of the month

- Linux and OSS are all about scratching your itch
- Then you provide a solution
- If you have a problem, someone else probably did
- So always look at what's out there!
- You will find many cool tools.

Monitoring progress: pv

- Command line tools sometimes lack a progress bar
- In a script, you can just display "please wait"
- The user can get impatient...
- ... or complain the program hung when it's just slogging through.
- Here comes pv, a progress bar tool.



Example: tar

- Tar can show progress by listing a list of files. Not very helpful.
- Example:

```
tar -zcvf /tmp/archive.tar.Z somedir
./somedir/a_file
./somedir/another_file
./somedir/oh_look_yet_another_file
etc...
```

A better way:
 tar -zcf - somedir | pv -rb > /tmp/archive.tar.Z
 136MB [25.9MB/s]

The counter is updated in place. -r: rate, -b: byte counter.

Todo list: Task Warrior

- Many places have a formal task management system (e.g., JIRA).
- But what about little tasks not worth opening a ticket?
- Scraps of paper? How so 20th century.
- Enter Task Warrior.

Task Warrior

- TW is a CLI program to let you manage a task list.
 Install from usual repos
- Open any terminal and type task add:
 task add 'Select cool tools for LUG meeting'
 A configuration file could not be found in /home/fmora
 Would you like a sample /home/fmora/.taskrc created, so
 taskwarrior can proceed? (yes/no) yes
 Created task 1.
- You can edit ~/.taskrc to pick a color scheme. I like light-256.

Task Warrior (cont'd)

Show current tasks with task list:

task list

 When a task is done: task xx done, where xx is the number or the text of the task task Harass done is equivalent to task 4 done.

Task Warrior (cont'd)

- Edit tasks to add parents/children, notes, time spent...
- Share the ~/.task dir with a file sync tool and use your task list on any machine!
- Many more tricks. See the web site taskwarrior.org.

Minitube: Archiving Youtube

- Ever had a problem demoing a Youtube video because of bandwidth?
 - Customer access to Youtube is blocked
 - Toddler wants his Youtube while you are driving through a network wasteland
- If only there was a way to archive these videos to a local file and play them back later...
- Of course, that's what Minitube is.

- Click Download
- Video will be saved in MPEG4 format
- Can be played back with VLC.
