# Local IT Market Data

- Unemployment:
  - National – 6.1% Local – 6.7%
  - National IT – 2.7% Local IT – 1.8%
- Total IT workforce - 16,960 Permanent – 14,416 Temp – 2,544
- Network/Systems Admins and Engineer's:
  - Total – 1,460 Permanent – 1,241 Temp 219
  - Density – Strong

# Linux Admin/Engineer's

- Supply & Demand – Based on a 50 mile radius from Norwalk
  - Demand – 3600 Job postings where there is Linux involved
  - Supply – 1274 Candidates who has some knowledge of Linux
  - Hiring Indicator – 43
- Compensation:
  - Average Salary - \$106,784 High - \$140k+ Low - \$60k
  - Average Temp wage - \$57/hr High - \$85/hr Low - \$45/hr
